Outline your presentation and organize key thoughts to build to a logical conclusion.

- 2. Overview/Introduce Problem
- 3. Outline Objectives
- 4. Objective 1 (2,3, to...n)
  - a. Learning Goal 1
  - b. Learning Goal 2
  - c. Audience Activity or Quiz
- 5. Conclusion
  - a.Summarize Goals
- 6.Questions

### **Building a Slide**

- Keep you message concise!
  Do not use big blocks of text.
- Use **illustrations** for key concepts!
- Create a <u>color and font scheme</u> for your presentation!
  - Go to the Creative Services website for the <u>UAMS</u> <u>template</u>.
- Be neat!
  - Do not put too many items in one slide.
- Ensure that the font is **legible and large enough** to read!

Increased audience participation <u>increases</u> information retention!
